

Uniform DRESS & TUXEDO INFO

Uniformity makes our choir look exceptional. It is important that each performer looks the same so that they do not distract the audience from the music. Contact the Uniform Coordinator immediately if there is a problem you cannot take care of by performance time. There will be a uniform check prior to each performance. Students may be asked not to perform if their uniform does not meet the following requirements:

DRESSES

- ☑ **Always try your dress on at home before coming to a performance.** Zippers can burst because girls have grown since the previous performance.
- ☑ **Not too tight!** You cannot sing properly if you cannot expand your lungs.
- ☑ **Be sure the dress is clean and pressed.** No wrinkles please.
- ☑ **Any simple black dress shoe or dress sandal is acceptable.** Comfort is important since you will be standing for a long period of time. Clean and/or shine your shoes.
- ☑ **Hems should be 2" from the floor when wearing your performance dress shoes.** If you wear different shoes than the ones worn to hem the dress, check to make sure the hem is still 2" from the floor. If a girl grows, the dress may be too short so always try your dress on at home before a performance in time to deal with any problems.
- ☑ **Black nylons or knee-hi's must be worn!** No bare feet or legs may show!
- ☑ **No jewelry except for small simple stud earrings.** No necklaces, bracelets, watches, rings, toe rings, anklets, large or drop earrings, etc.
- ☑ **Hair styles should be neat and attractive, not distracting.** No colorful dyes or colorful hairpieces please.

TUXEDOS

- ☑ **Always try your tux on at home before coming to a performance.** Zippers and buttons can burst because a boy has grown since the previous performance.
- ☑ **Not too tight!** You cannot sing properly if you cannot expand your lungs.
- ☑ **Be sure the tux is clean and pressed.** No wrinkles please.

- ☑ **Any simple black dress shoe is acceptable.** Comfort is important since you will be standing for a long period of time. Clean and/or shine your shoes. **Absolutely NO TENNIS SHOES!**
- ☑ **Pant leg hems should go over the top of your performance dress shoes front and back, and completely cover your *black* socks.** If a boy grows, the pants may be too short so always try your tux on at home before a performance in time to deal with any problems.
- ☑ **Black socks must be worn!** No bear feet or legs or other colored socks may show!
- ☑ **No jewelry whatsoever.** No necklaces, bracelets, watches, rings, earrings, etc.
- ☑ **Don't forget your bow tie!** Keep it hanging on the hanger or in a tux pocket.
- ☑ **Hair styles should be neat and attractive, not distracting.** No colorful dyes or extreme hair styles please.
